WHO: Seven would-be farmers/ranchers of Hispanic/Native American heritage

WHAT: Graduation ceremony of the first business-education class of [ADENTRO](#), a new program from the Office of Rural and Farmworker Housing.

WHEN: Tonight – March 19, 2014
6 – 8 p.m. (dinner followed by graduation ceremony)

WHERE: Smith Hall
Heritage University, Toppenish campus
3240 Fort Road, Toppenish, WA 98948

WHY: To bring would-be business owners who lack access to capital and conventional financing *adentro* (“inside”) and equip them with the tools to become successful entrepreneurs.

HOW: ADENTRO offers small loans to qualified individuals who lack access to conventional financing. Many are farmworkers with great expertise in agriculture, but who need education in building a business plan, gaining a bank loan, etc. They must complete 10 weeks of business education classes.
